The Wilkes Barre Area CTC 9th grade Career Exploration program is designed to allow students to explore different Career Clusters and begin to form the skills necessary to achieve success in the many career pathways that are offered at the WBACTC.

Students will be grouped into cohorts where they will be moved throughout the Career Exploration curriculum by the Wilkes Barre Area CTC Career Exploration Guides.

The cohorts will spend approximately 17 school days in a particular career cluster classroom where they will explore the specific fields that are under the cluster as well as the unique skills and knowledge that will be needed to be successful in those career paths.

Activities will include group projects, live demonstrations of equipment, class speakers, field trips, tours, industry recognized certification training and more.

Students who complete the Career Exploration program will be able to choose the program of study they will like to pursue at the Wilkes Barre Area CTC for 10th grade.
